Dear Parent/Guardian:

As part of our "no Child Left Behind" legislation, parents of each student attending a Title I School may request information regarding the professional qualification of their child's classroom teacher. The same regulation applies to a teaching assistant that may be assigned to your child's classroom.

If you request this information in writing, the district will respond to you in writing within ten school days. The information will be provided in an understandable and uniform format, in a language you can understand.

The response will include the following information:

1. Whether the teacher has met the State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
3. The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification degree, and
4. Whether the child is provided services by teaching assistants and, if so, their qualifications.

The district makes every effort to ensure that all teachers and teaching assistants are highly qualified.
