- 24 sharpened #2 wooden pencils & extra erasers (large pink pearl work well)
- 2 pens (1 RED & 1 BLUE)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 pack of crayons (16 or 24 count- No larger)
- 1 pair of pointed student scissors (Fiskars preferred)
- 1 pencil case (soft zippered fits better in desk)
- 2 folders with brads (1 RED, 1 BLUE)
- 5 sturdy pocket folders (1 will be for ART)
- 1 Mead composition notebook -100 sheets, wide-rule
- 1 pkg. wide loose-leaf paper (unopened to share as needed)
- 2 pkgs. 3"x 5" index cards
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pkg. dry erase markers (Expo 4pk. Low odor)-(unopened to share as needed)
- 1 old sock to use as an eraser
- 2 large boxes of tissues (any additional would be appreciated)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
