

Candidates for Board Members

To qualify for membership on a school board, an individual:

1. Must be able to read and write.
2. Must be a qualified voter of the district, that is, citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older and not adjudged to be incompetent.
3. Must be and have been a resident (but need not be a taxpayer) of the district for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one year immediately before the election.
4. May not have been removed from any school office within the preceding year.
5. May not reside with another member of the same board as a member of the same family.
6. May not be a current employee of the school board.
7. May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office.
8. May file a petition with the Clerk of the Board of Education or Shared Business Manager no later than Monday, April 16, 2018, at 4:00 p.m.

Must be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the District and must state the residence of each signer.

Blank applications will be available on March 13, 2018, at the District Office at the UPK-12 Building during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., except on weekends and holidays.

Candidates shall be arranged according to lot and the drawing will be conducted on Tuesday, April 17.
